- A hearse to transport the deceased to the place of cremation
- A choice of the cremation day and time Monday-Thursday 9.00 a.m. or 9.15 a.m. In line with the crematoria instructions, there will be no formal funeral service. Up to 3 pieces of music may be played within the 10 minute service time. A maximum of 8 mourners may be present in the crematorium chapel
