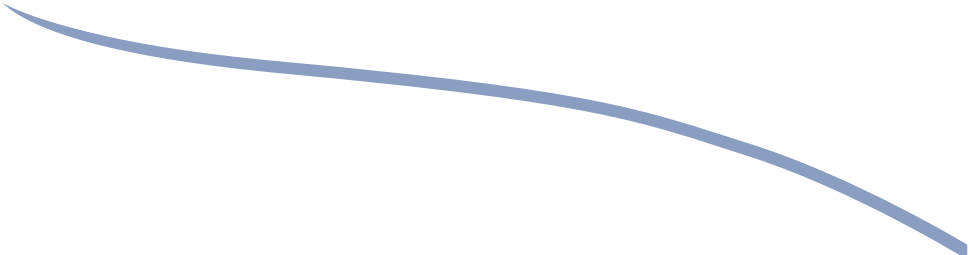

You may also choose a day and time for an attended direct cremation	✓ As members of SAIF our premises are inspected to meet standards set for care of the deceased	✓ All our Direct Cremations are carried out at Wessex Vale or Southampton Crematoriums
✗ Arrangements only made over the telephone	✗ Often taken in a van or ambulance with multiple deceased for cremation	✗ Often no day and time given and attending is not an option	✗ Often providers are not funeral directors and do not belong to a trade association	✗ Often the cremation is not carried out locally. Always ask where the cremation will take place
